Do not add pages except where indicated in sections C, D, E & K. **One extra sheet required if submitting points for *C, D, E., K** 5. You must be exhibiting an ANGUS to receive showmanship points. To receive points in judging, beef cattle must be part of the contest. Speeches or talks must pertain to Angus or beef industry. 6. In the event of a tie, the tie will be broken in Category D, NJAS Contests.
