Committee Reports

Miss Kansas Angus and Ambassador - 2022 Miss Kansas Angus Greta Rosenhagen talked about her year thus far, aside from being very active in school, she made it to some sales and show. She plans on attending the NJAS and attend the Futurity in January. Addie Haverkamp is the 2022 Kansas Angus Ambassador and has attended sales and shows as well this year. She will be attending the NJAS as well as plans to attend some sales and shows this fall.

Ways and Means - Mary McCurry reported that Prairie Oaks is still taking orders and they are ready for holiday orders. They have added holiday items. Items will remain in the \$50 price range, allowing us to profit about \$25 on each item. Anne mentioned, if reminded, she will post on Facebook before each holiday. We will put together a flyer for the NJAS and put in welcome bags and have some examples on display.

Kansas Auxiliary Scholarship - Brenna represented the scholarship committee. They had 1 applicant which will be announced tomorrow after the bred and owned show.

American Angus Auxiliary - Anne Lampe announced we have 4 Cook-Off teams this year. Tonya mentioned there will be a social at the NJAS on Wednesday at 3:15pm onsite. They are looking for items to give as a taste of KS for about 60-65 ladies. If anyone has anything that they would like to add please let her know.

Old Business

Mary McCurry spoke about moving the CD's from past NJAS into a foundation scholarship. Lori Fink and Mary McCurry met with Thomas and Jaclyn (Angus Foundation) in Manhattan. They are proposing creating a scholarship that will benefit Kansas juniors. KS will be in charge of selecting our own recipient. Wording needs to be worked on as far as age, application, who is eligible (KS or others). Mary stated they need \$30,000 to start this and it will need to incubate for 3 years before we can pull any money out. The foundation is waiving some administration fees. Jessica Brunker moved to pull the money from the NJAS Small CD and NJAS Large CD along with the remainder coming from checking in order to start our Foundation scholarship. We can work on wording later. Kim Hill seconded the motion and the motion passed.

NJAS update from Anne. Anne spoke about the Cook Off Teams and who was in charge of each of those teams. She also mentioned the Cook Off T-Shirts costed more than expected coming in at \$2463.97. The Auxiliary is going to pay \$2000 as voted on at the

January 2022 meeting. IF Kansas Jr's plan to volunteer they may arrive early and set up no earlier than 3pm July 1. The children's area is looking for toys, games, coloring pages, and board games for the kids area. The Info office is needing volunteers and many other areas will need volunteers so please help if possible.

New Business

Tonya appointed Ashley Navisky to the scholarship committee to serve 3 years.
