The Annual Meeting of the Kansas Junior Angus Association's Futurity Show was called to order by President Kelsey Theis on January 25th, 2025. As the roll call sheet was passed among juniors, there were 36 members present with five new members.

The new members announced their name, age, and where they are from. These members were: Chason Schilling, Peyton Abbots, Abby Brown, Rhett Post, and Jett Clark. Eliza Rosenhagen moved for the minutes approval, Kaelyn Schilling seconded, motion passed.

During the Treasurer's report, Cohen Navinsky reported a total of \$49,404.58. Additionally, he noted the \$5,487.08 of expenses and \$9,872.00 of income leaving the junior association with a balance of \$43,850.

Membership Director Molly Hill reported that the Kick-Ball game was going to be held in the show-ring following the annual meeting. This activity had 25 members participate. Next Kelsey Theis reminded everyone about the auction of sponsoring our state's T-Shirts for the Junior Show. She reminded everyone of the procedure, availability of spots, and who to deliver/mail the checks to. Addie Haverkamp reminded members to think of a display for our NJAS Booth and that any ideas can be shared with her during or after the meeting.

In the Advisor reports Brenna brought up the idea of making a budget with the money in our treasury and that we could discuss it in new business. Anne reminded members to join the KJAA Facebook group page and newsletter for any updates for the association.

No Old Business was discussed

In New Business members voted on the two individuals that would serve as Kansas's voting delegates for the 2025 National Junior Angus Show. Five members came in front of the audience and said their name and why they would be a good delegate for our association. After results were counted, Eliza Rosenhagen and Cohen Navinsky were chosen to represent our state. Additionally, the KJAA unanimously endorsed Lyle Perrier as our Junior Board Candidate and will represent Kansas at the Junior Show in Tulsa OK.

Next, members were tasked to come up with community service ideas. In addition to local community service, members were reminded to collect pop tabs for the NJAA's community service project.

Aubree McCurry made a motion to allocate a \$500 donation for the National Junior Angus Show division sponsorship. - Molly Hill seconded, motion passed. In response to Brenna's idea of creating a budget, members discussed the income/expenses needed for the budget plan as well as setting a completion date of June 1st, 2025. Cooper Woodrow moved to create the budget and Sullivan Haverkamp seconded, motion passed.

During announcements, Kelsey Theis reminded members of the Futurity Show's rules and regulations as well as the start time and breakfast opening for Sunday morning. In conclusion June 6th and 7th will be the dates for the KJAA Preview Show. Drew McCurry moved to adjourn the meeting. Jett McCurry seconded; motion passed.
